On Monday, our year 4 children were invited to bring their bikes into school to take part in a level 1 Bikeability course, the children had a valuable and fun morning. At Level 1; new riders learn to control and master their bikes in an off-road environment and teaches riders how to control and master their bikes. At Level 1 you can:

- prepare yourself and your bike for cycling
- get on and off your bike without help
- start off, pedal and stop with control
- pedal along, use gears and avoid objects
- look all around and behind, and control the bike
- share space with pedestrians and other cyclists
