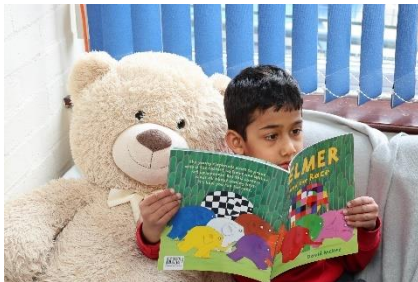

30 Hours Nursery Funding

Parents need to apply before the end of 31st March 2024 for a 30-hour funding code if you wish to use it from April 2024. If the code is dated the 1st April onwards then you are not eligible to claim the extended entitlement until September 2024.

Parents with existing codes are required to reconfirm their 30-hour code before the end of March deadline, to ensure their code remains eligible for the Summer term. You must check your account regularly or approximately every 3 months to make sure that your code is up-to-date and valid.
